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2025 Atlantic Hurricane Season Predictions

Meteorologists are predicting near to above-average activity in the Atlantic for the upcoming hurricane season. On average, forecasts are calling for 15 named storms, slightly above the 30-year average of 14, with 8 of those expected to become hurricanes and 3 of those becoming major hurricanes. Peak activity typically occurs in mid-September. Elevated sea surface temperatures and a transition from La Niña to neutral conditions are the main factors contributing to the forecast for a slightly above-average hurricane season.
